

**ORDINANCE No. 2015-06**  
**Ordinance Establishing 25 Mile per Hour**  
**Speed Zone on South Street**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 349.11 (3)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, towns have certain limited authority to set speed limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Brooklyn, of Green Lake County, has determined that the actual speed of vehicles on South Street is greater than is reasonable and prudent; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town finds that within any 1,000 feet along South Street, the buildings in use for business, industrial or residential purposes fronting thereon average not more than 200 feet apart or where the buildings in use for such purposes fronting on both sides of the highway considered collectively average not more than 200 feet apart.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BROOKLYN, GREEN LAKE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, THAT:**

1. The speed limit on South Street shall be changed from 40 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour (Town jurisdiction County A West to City Limits).
2. Speed limit signs shall be posted in the manner and size required by law.
3. This ordinance shall be effective only upon the passage and publication of an ordinance by the Town of Brooklyn which reduces the speed limit on South Street to 25 miles per hour and by the posting of the 25 mile per hour speed limit signs.
4. The Town authorizes the City of Green Lake Police Department and the County of Green Lake Sheriff's Department to enforce the speed limit on South Street from County A west to the city limits of the City of Green Lake.
5. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication pursuant to the requirements of Section 60.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
